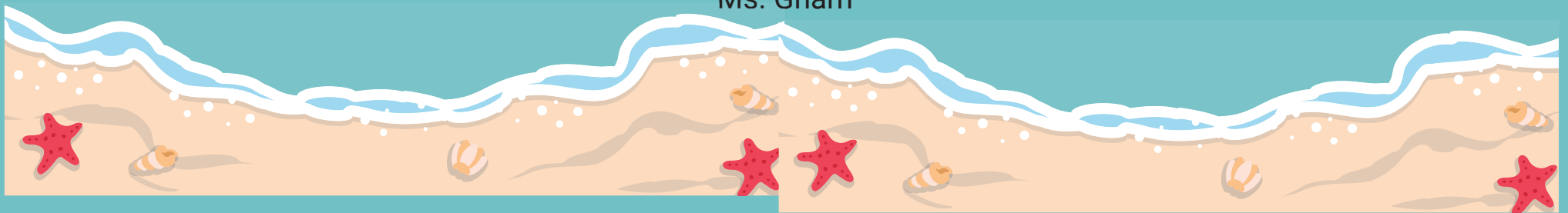

Grade 4-6 Science: The grade 4-6s have reached the end of their respective weather units. They were last seen working on a poster about an extreme weather event, such as volcano eruption, tornado, or hurricane. We will be looking to finish the remaining science as efficiently as we can.

Grade 6 Social: In Social we have officially finished our curriculum for the year, and are doing our final unit test later this week. From here we will be looking towards PAT prep in other classes.
